Suffolk Safeguarding Adults Framework Consultation

We are about to consult on the Suffolk Safeguarding Adults Framework that will provide all staff working with adults in Suffolk guidance on how to manage potential safeguarding concerns. The consultation commences on 1st October 2018 and will close on 9th November 2018.

The Suffolk Safeguarding Adults Framework has been developed in accordance with the Suffolk Safeguarding multi-agency review recommendations. The framework promotes collaborative working across Suffolk and aims to ensure that safeguarding is everyone's responsibility and is central to the promotion of people's well-being.

We need your help to further develop the Framework and ensure that it is fit for purpose for all staff working with adults with care and support needs in Suffolk. We are holding four workshops that will give people the opportunity to feedback on the draft document. The dates and times of the workshops are as follows:

- 1st October 2018 from 13:00 to 16:30 at Suffolk Constabulary Headquarters, Martlesham, room LEC 2.
- 15th October 2018 from 13:00 to 16:30 at Great Yarmouth & Waveney CCG Headquarters, Beccles.
- 26th October 2018 from 09:30 to 13:00 at West Suffolk Hospital, Bury St Edmunds.
- 1st November 2018 from 10:00 to 16:00 at Landmark House, Ipswich. There will be 3 sessions, first starting at 10:00, then the second at 12:00 and the third at 14:00. Each session is 2 hours long, individuals can pop along to any session.
